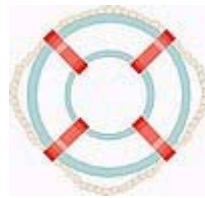
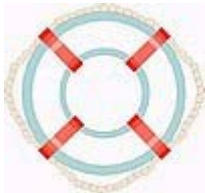
# MANHATTAN DELI
